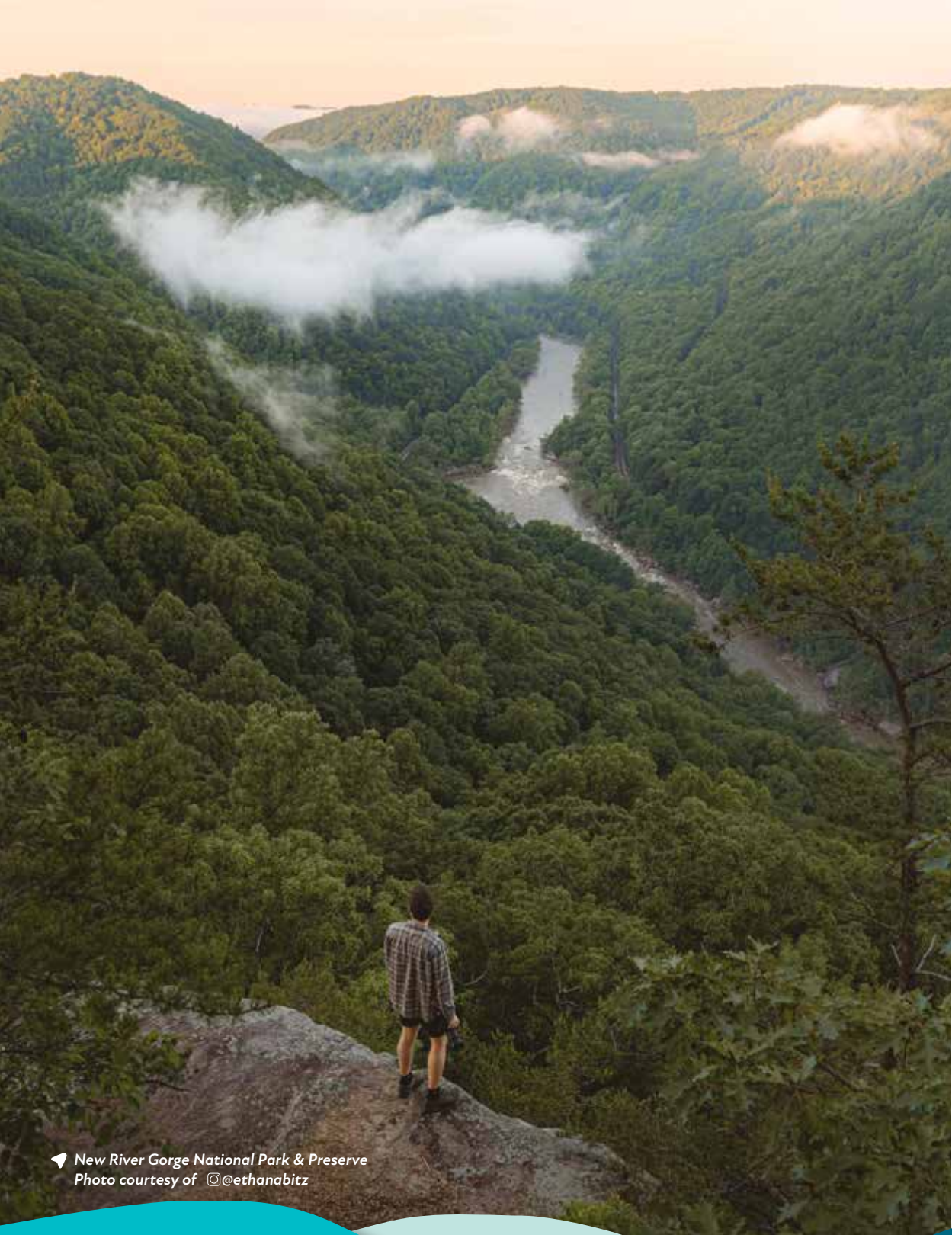

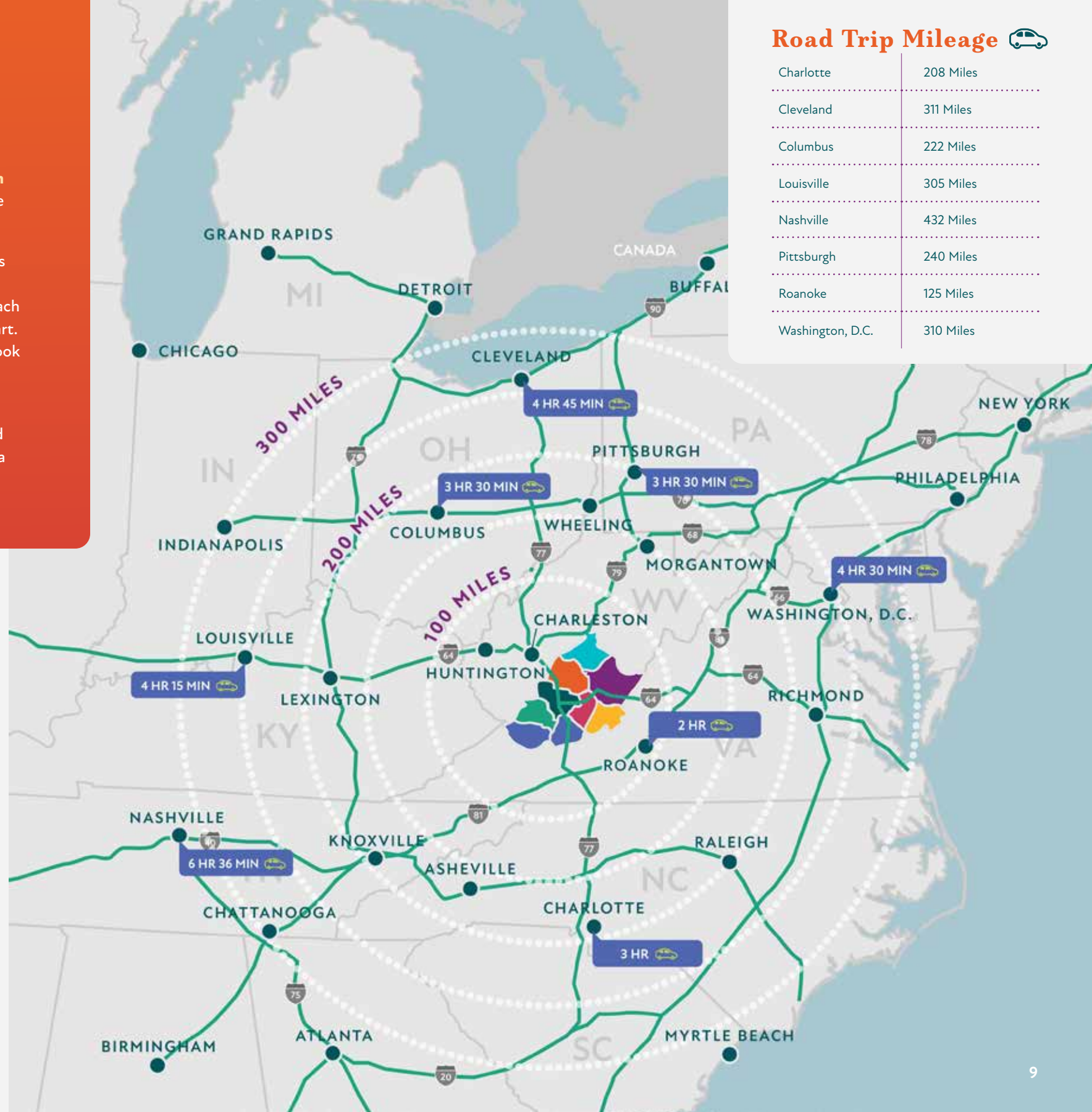

Meet America's 63rd National Park.

Experience the outdoor adventures and scenic views of the 63rd National Park — the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve — in Southern West Virginia.

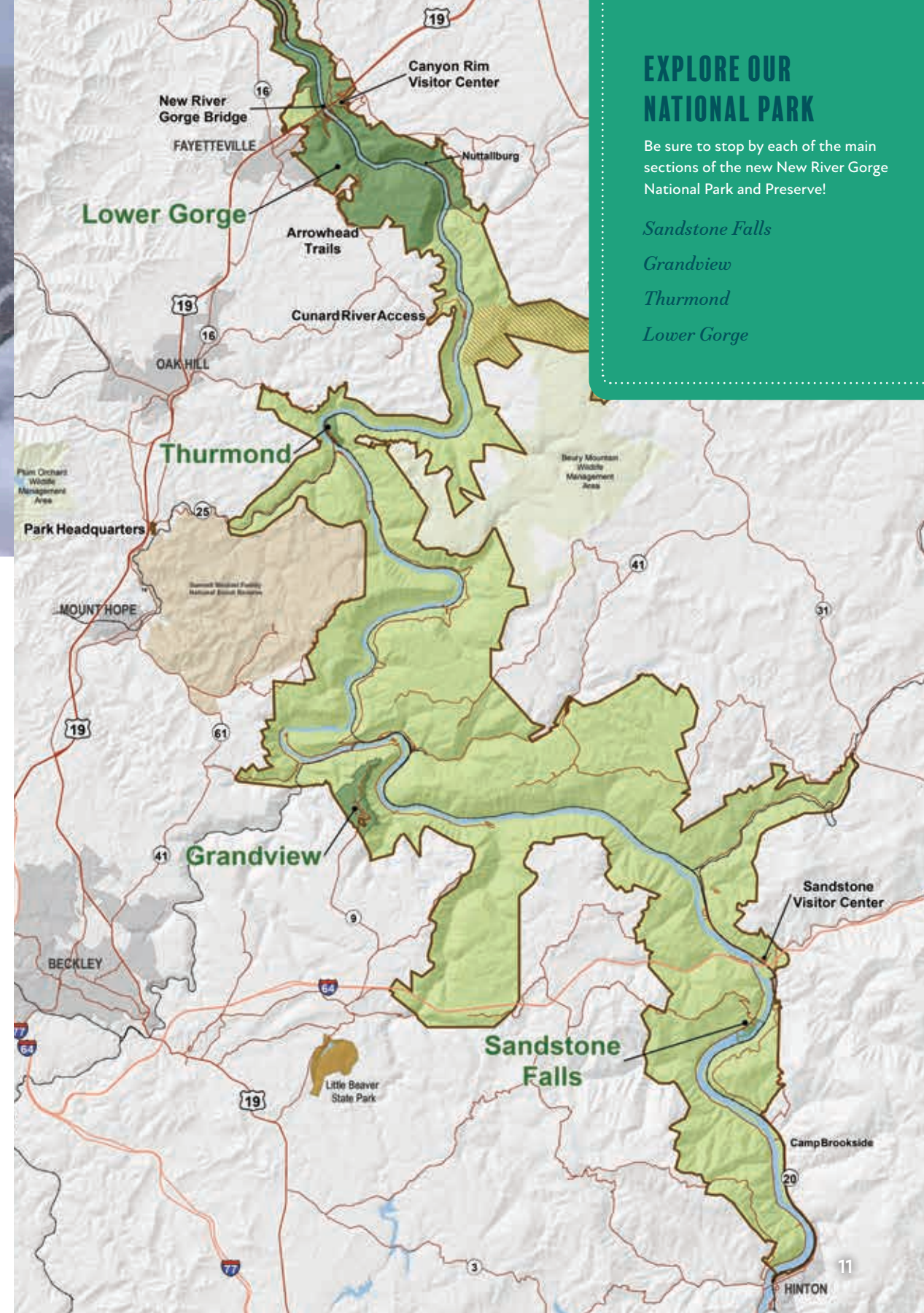
The area was originally established in 1978 as a National River. Then, on December 27, 2020, the 53-mile stretch of river along with 70,000+ acres were redesignated as the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve.

The 7,000 acres that make up the National Park are located in four areas: Sandstone Falls, Grandview, Thurmond and the Lower New River Gorge. The preserve portion encompasses the remaining 65,000 acres. The park is now one of three sites in Southern West Virginia managed by the National Park System, along with the Gauley River National Recreation Area and Bluestone National Scenic River. The combined National Park sites extend

through five counties in Southern West Virginia: Fayette, Mercer, Nicholas, Raleigh and Summers.

Adventure can be found throughout the park. Paddle down miles of free-flowing whitewater rapids on the New River, one of the oldest rivers on the continent, or explore the old railroad town of Hinton, home to Sandstone Falls, the largest waterfall on the New River. Hike the serene forest trails at Grandview for panoramic views of the Gorge and striking displays of Catawba rhododendron in the late spring, or step back in time on a walking tour through the abandoned ghost town of Thurmond.

Among these activities, the park and preserve also offers camping, mountain biking, fishing and hunting. Find your own way to explore the rivers, forests and canyons of West Virginia's national park lands.

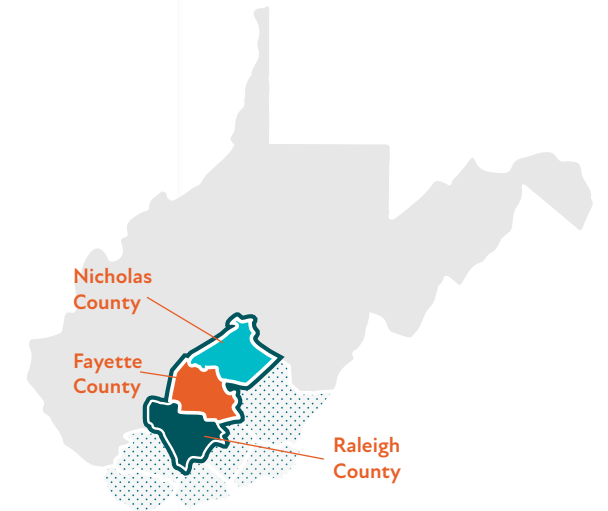

RALEIGH COUNTY

A FOUR-SEASON DESTINATION

No matter the weather, Raleigh County's forecast guarantees a fun-filled day.

SKI

Southern West Virginia is truly a year-round getaway, and with the region's most accessible ski resort, Raleigh County is the starting point for all winter activities.

Hit the slopes at Winterplace Ski Resort, conveniently located off I-77 in Ghent. The resort has over 90 acres of skiable land, including 27 trails of varying difficulty levels, and a terrain park. Elevate your experience

Winterplace has 100 percent snowmaking capacity.

with 10 lifts, accessing runs that climb 3,600 feet and offer exhilarating 603-foot vertical drops. The fun doesn't stop after dark: enjoy night skiing on 26 of the 27 trails. Additionally, experience the state's largest tubing park, boasting up to 14 lanes of snow tubing fun.

Beginners are welcome! Winterplace offers skiing and snowboarding lessons and is the number one place in the state for newcomers learning to ski, with more than a quarter of the slopes geared toward beginners.

Burning Rock Outdoor Adventure Park, located 15 minutes from Beckley, is a 10,000-acre park with 100 miles of well-kept off-road trails for biking, ATV and UTV riding, Jeeps and trucks. If you don't have a vehicle, rentals are available through a third party. Contact Burning Rock for more details. It's a great getaway for the experienced off-roader and mud bogger or a thrilling trip for new riders looking to expand their horizons.

Stay close to all the action and make a weekend — or week — out of your adventures with Burning Rock's many lodging options. The park has a campground, rustic cabins, RV hookups, glamping with plush amenities and a bunkhouse for larger groups.

For an unmatched experience, take advantage of Raleigh County's exciting outdoor recreation and one-of-a-kind attractions. You won't be disappointed by the variety of sights along the way.

GOLF

Tee off in Raleigh County! From challenging links to family-friendly fairways, you'll find a course designed for all levels and ages.

Start your day of golfing at one of the region's premier golf courses at Glade Springs. The courses at Glade Springs boasts three 18-hole championship golf courses amid a scenic mountain backdrop. For a shorter course, hit the links at the Historic Black Knight in Beckley. Open to the public, this course proves there's always "time for nine!"

Looking for a different challenge? Head to Mountain State Miniature Golf for a memorable game, featuring 18 holes centered around famous themes from West Virginia history.



HIKE

Some of Southern West Virginia's finest natural beauty can be seen from the vast network of hiking trails in Raleigh County.

GRANDVIEW

Enjoy the best views of the New River Gorge landscape at the appropriately named Grandview. Included in the National Park Service's New River Gorge National Park and Preserve, Grandview offers spectacular sights of the New River from overlooks and six miles of hiking trails. One of the best-known spots is its Main Overlook where visitors can look directly onto the horseshoe bend of the New River from 1,400 feet above.

Take a hike to discover some of the state's most majestic views and waterfalls.

Plan a trip in the spring to see the area's display of Catawba rhododendrons, West Virginia's state flower. Bloom times differ slightly, so check with a park ranger about the best time to visit.

GLADE CREEK

The Glade Creek area is beautiful, serene – and packed full of waterfalls. From an enjoyable stroll that follows a narrow railroad (Glade Creek Trail) to a steep and rugged route that ends at an amazing mountain cascade (Kates Falls Trail), casual sightseers and avid hikers will be able to find the perfect trail here. The Glade Creek area is also home to popular swimming holes and fishing spots.

LITTLE BEAVER STATE PARK

With 562 acres of outdoor adventures, Little Beaver State Park is a wonderful place to spend your day. Choose from over 20 miles of hiking trails, or get out on the water at the park's 18-acre lake. Water activities include fishing, paddleboarding, kayaking and canoeing. All are available for rent seasonally.

PINEY CREEK

Discover the Piney Creek Trail system. This 10-mile network of trails winds through lush woods, leading to the edge of the Piney Creek Gorge.



The Piney Creek Preserve opened its' first 1/2 mile trail to the public in 2023: the Waterfall Hollow Trail located on Stanaford Mine Road. This trail provides access to two of the Piney Creek tributary streams' most scenic waterfalls — Little White Stick Falls and Cranberry Creek Cascades. Both are check in points on the West Virginia Waterfall Trail.

ON THE LAKE

Escape to Lake Stephens and enjoy the great outdoors. The 272-acre mountain lake sits in the middle of a 2,000-acre hardwood forest and offers disc golf, boating, fishing, swimming and an aqua water park and splash pad as well as over 20 miles of hiking and biking trails. With cabin rentals ranging in size and options for RV and tent camping, you can stay and play at Lake Stephens.

Beckley Exhibition Coal Museum

BECKLEY EXHIBITION COAL MINE

Discover the depths of Southern West Virginia's coal mining history at the Beckley Exhibition Coal Mine. Open seasonally from April through November 1, the once-operational mine welcomes thousands of visitors each year. Step back in time as you explore the underground mine, guided by veteran miners who bring the experience to life. Above ground, immerse yourself in the restored period coal camp buildings to see what life was like for the miners and their families.

YOUTH MUSEUM OF SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA

Located footsteps away from the Beckley Exhibition Coal Mine, the Youth Museum of Southern West Virginia is open to the public year-round. The museum provides opportunities for educational programs in an interactive environment. While at the museum, visit the Mountain Homestead, a recreated settlement from the Appalachian frontier. Learn about West Virginia's pioneer settlers from knowledgeable guides and tour the grounds, which includes a restored log cabin, one-room schoolhouse, barn, weaver's shed and more.

HISTORY RUNS DEEP

IN BECKLEY, RALEIGH COUNTY

Visit one of the area's local landmarks to explore the rich history of Beckley-Raleigh County.

Take a journey through history by touring the Wildwood House Museum. This double log structure, built in 1839 and once home to Beckley's founder, General Alfred Beckley, offers visitors a unique opportunity to explore the area's rich past. The museum is open during the summer and available for pre-arranged visits and special events throughout the year.

The Beckley Raleigh County Veterans Museum showcases a collection of over

30,000 artifacts, covering a range of exhibits from the Revolutionary War to the War on Terror.

Beckley-Raleigh County is the childhood home of Bill Withers, a Grammy-winning musician, Songwriters Hall of Fame inductee (2005) and Rock & Roll Hall of Fame inductee (2015). A Raleigh County Historical Society marker, located across from his former high school, recognizes his impact on music. The site now hosts the new building for Stratton Elementary School.

Art plays a special role in the culture of Southern West Virginia. Discover the talented artists and rich culture of the region by visiting the museums, theaters and art galleries of Raleigh County.

TAMARACK MARKETPLACE

Experience the vibrant creativity and culture of West Virginia at Tamarack Marketplace. This cultural hub features work by talented individuals from every corner of West Virginia and is known for its artisan products, fine art, hands-on workshops, live entertainment and Appalachian-inspired cuisine. Spend a day browsing handmade goods, strolling through galleries and taking in all of the amazing displays. You might even catch a demonstration from the resident glass blower or a studio artist. Indulge in the local flavors at Tamarack's food court, where you can savor the taste of West Virginia before you leave.

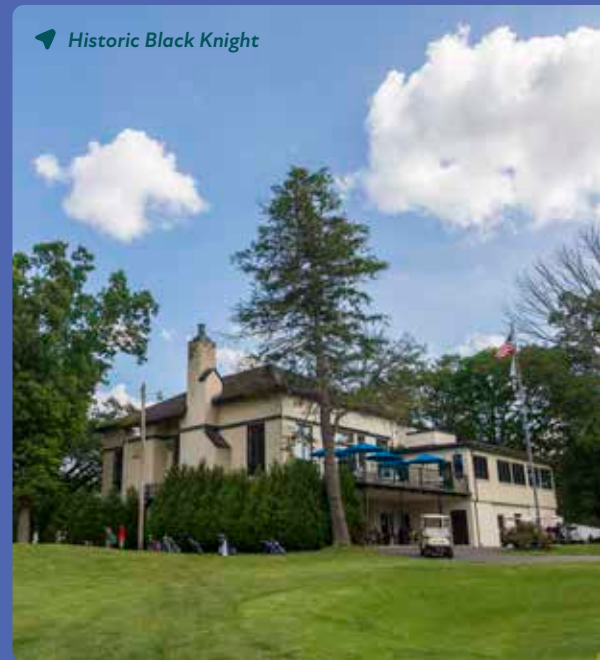
THEATRE WEST VIRGINIA

Watch as your favorite performances come to life under the stars at the picturesque Cliffside Amphitheatre at Grandview — New River Gorge National Park and Preserve. Established in 1955, Theatre West Virginia strives to present West Virginia's unique history through entertaining and critically acclaimed historical dramas every year, such as "Hatfields and McCoy's" and "Honey in the Rock."

THE BLACK KNIGHT

Originally opened as The Black Knight Country Club, this property was organized in 1928–29 when Col. Ernest Chilson, general manager and VP of Raleigh Coal & Coke, offered more than 60 acres of company property for a golf course and clubhouse. The club's name came from the "Black Knight" trademark of the coal company.

Today, this community gathering place owned by the City of Beckley retains its historic charm and casual elegance and boasts a nine-hole golf course, catering and food options. The venue is a very popular event, wedding and meeting facility.

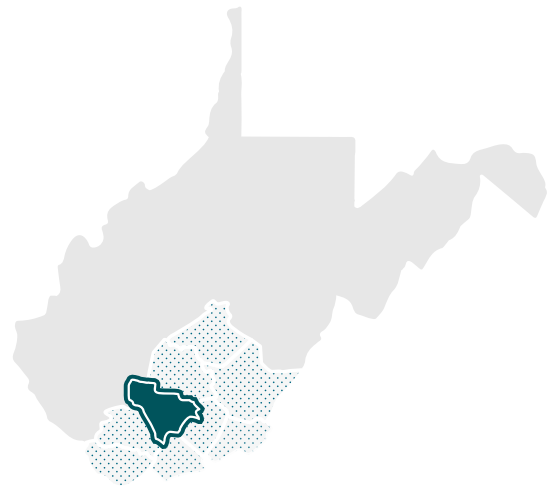

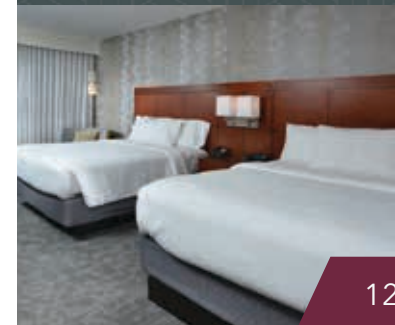

OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

IN FAYETTE COUNTY

With the lower section of the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve in its backyard, Fayette County is a playground for outdoor recreation.

WHITewater RAFTING

The New River Gorge is known for its free-flowing whitewater. Here, thrill seekers have the choice between the New River or nearby Gauley River – both of which are divided into two sections – depending on your age, skill and experience level.

The New River is one of the oldest rivers in the world. Families, groups with younger children or those simply wanting a more mild ride can paddle down the Upper New. The Lower New, with Class V rapids, is a step above, making it a great choice for enthusiastic first-timers as well as seasoned rafters.

For the ultimate adrenaline rush, look no further than the Gauley River. Known as the “Beast of the East,” the Gauley is consistently ranked one of the top five in the world to raft and in the top three to raft in the United States. Due to scheduled releases from the Summersville Dam during Gauley Season (September-October), these rapids are truly as wild as they come. While the Lower Gauley is similar to the Lower New, with Class III-V rapids, the Upper Gauley features iconic Class V rapids — the “Big 5” — Insignificant, Pillow Rock, Lost Paddle, Iron Ring and Sweet’s Falls.

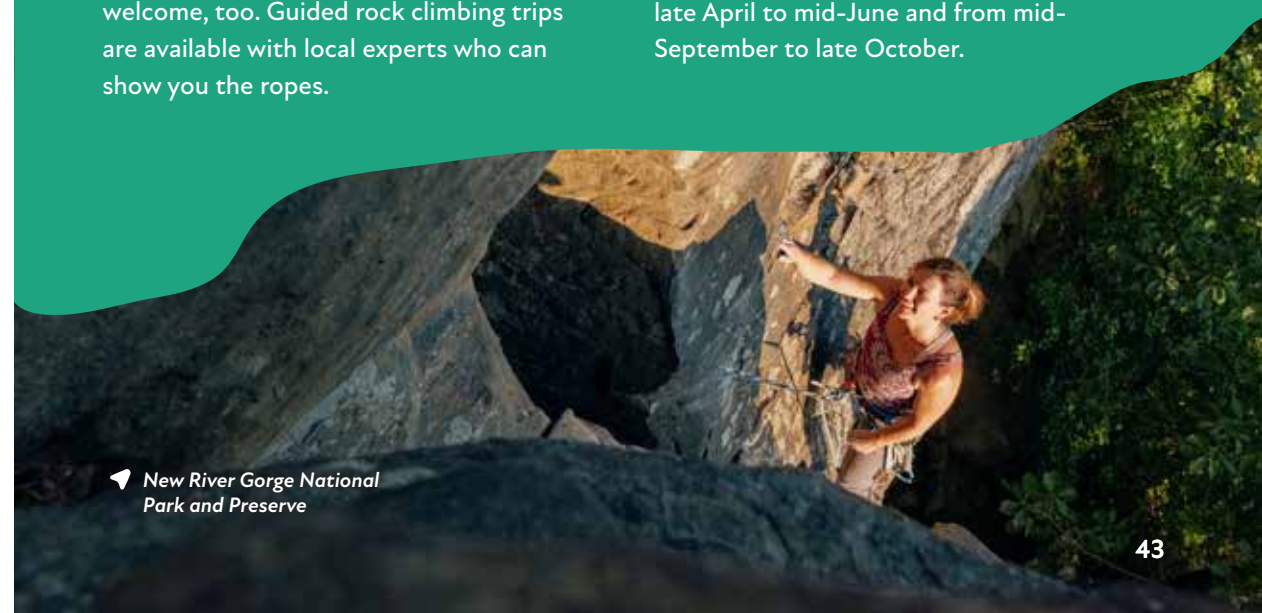
ROCK CLIMBING

In addition to whitewater, the New River Gorge is a rock climbing mecca. The region is one of the largest, most diverse and highest-quality climbing areas in the east.

More than 1,400 established climbs can be found within the park and preserve. Many routes are more suited for experienced climbers, but beginners are welcome, too. Guided rock climbing trips are available with local experts who can show you the ropes.

Located in Oak Hill, Needleseye Park is a hidden paradise. The park has incredible natural rock features, including a 2-mile rock wall, tunnels and sandstone cliffs that are ideal for bouldering (a style of rock climbing that is performed on small rock formations).

While the Gorge is accessible year-round, the best times to climb are from late April to mid-June and from mid-September to late October.

HIKING

Discover Fayette County’s natural wonders on over 100 trails in and around the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve.

Hike through the Burnwood Old-Growth Forest, where Eastern hemlocks, American beeches, red maples and other unique tree species thrive. Explore family-friendly rail trails, including the 1.8-mile Hawks Nest Rail Trail, revealing stunning waterfalls along Mill Creek, and the paved 7.9-mile White Oak Rail Trail in Oak Hill. For another accessible option, hike the Rend Trail. This 6.4-mile round-trip adventure provides scenic views of Dunloup Creek, the New River and the historic community of Thurmond. Suitable for hikers of all ages, the trail also serves as a great introduction for novice mountain bikers.

Uncover the area’s history along trails showcasing old coal communities and industrial remnants. From the easy Tipple Trail to the challenging Kaymoor Miner’s Trail, experience the coal camp legacy. The Nuttallburg Trails offer insights into industrial and community aspects of Henry Ford’s 1920s conveyor and tipple system.

With trails for all levels, Fayette County promises a diverse hiking experience amid rugged hills and rich history.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE

While hiking, we ask that you please abide by the National Park Service’s Leave No Trace Seven Principles®. Be mindful and stay on the trail to avoid damaging the surrounding environment and leave the area just as you found it. Additionally, during peak months many popular trails become congested. If trailhead parking lots are full, consider finding another great trail to hike in the area.



MOUNTAIN BIKING

Explore the intricate trails of Fayette County on a mountain biking excursion.

Find 12 miles of easy-to-intermediate paths on the Arrowhead Trails system in the Craig’s Branch area of the New River Gorge. The stacked loop trail system is great for mountain bikers of all skill levels and includes four trails — the Clovis, Adena, Dalton and LeCroy trails.

Experience Wolf Creek Park, a recreational area in Fayette County, featuring 17 miles of trails.

Soar through the sky over the rolling hills of the New River Gorge in a fully-restored World War II Stearman biplane with Wild Blue Adventure Company. During the 20-minute Gorge tour, you’ll be able to spot the New River, Endless Wall, Beauty Mountain, New River Gorge Bridge and Hawks Nest State Park and Dam.

Get picture-perfect views of the Gorge from down below on a jet boat tour with New River Jet Boats. After taking a scenic shuttle ride along Mill Creek from Hawks Nest State Park, hop on a jet boat upstream for a phenomenal look at the New River Gorge Bridge.

EXPLORE SMALL TOWNS IN FAYETTE COUNTY

Fayette County is home to a collection of charming small towns that offer a warm welcome to all visitors. Friendly locals, rich history and an abundance of natural beauty make these communities the perfect destination for those seeking a memorable escape from the bustle of city life.

FAYETTEVILLE

As the county seat of Fayette County, Fayetteville has garnered national attention over the last decade, earning titles such as “Coolest Small Town” and “Best River Town.” Located on the rim of the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve, the town is quaint and full of life. Fayetteville boasts a rich history, centered around the historic Fayette County Courthouse, but also offers plenty of opportunities for adventure and relaxation. Explore local art, visit unique shops and music venues, stretch at a yoga studio, enjoy a drink at a pub and brewery, or treat your taste buds to the delicious offerings of the town’s restaurants.

OAK HILL

The tight-knit community of Oak Hill is a great destination for family-friendly outings. From city parks to disc golf courses and even a bouldering area, there’s something for everyone. Enjoy a family walk or bike ride on the scenic White Oak Rail Trail, a nearly 8-mile paved trail running through Oak Hill. The city hosts the Oak Leaf Festival every fall as well as the annual Pumpkin Festival in October.

GAULEY BRIDGE

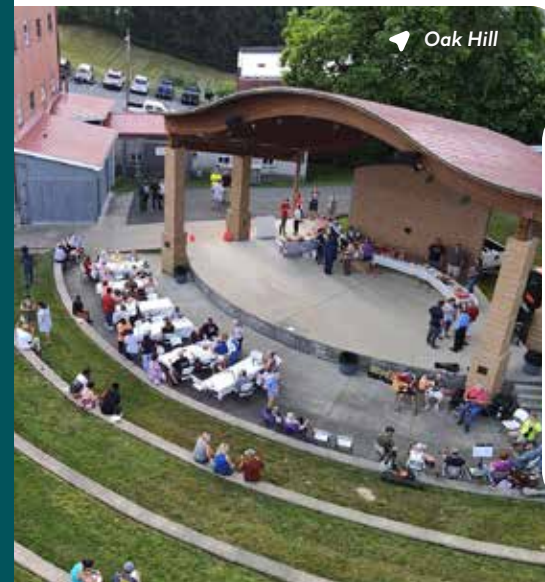
At the town of Gauley Bridge, the New and the Gauley Rivers combine to form the Kanawha River. The town got its name from the historic covered bridge that once spanned the Gauley River. The bridge was part of the James River & Kanawha Turnpike, a crucial transportation route. Gauley Bridge, Montgomery and Smithers are a few of the riverside communities along the Midland Trail (U.S. Route 60), a popular scenic drive. Follow this picturesque route and view two nearby waterfalls that are easily accessible from the road — Kanawha Falls and Cathedral Falls.

ANSTED

Continue on Route 60 to Ansted, home to Hawks Nest State Park. The 270-acre park is known for its scenic overlook — offering a bird’s eye view of the rugged New River Gorge National Park and Preserve below — as well as hiking trails, fishing, a nature center and a 31-room lodge and restaurant. Ansted is also home to many annual festivals and events, locally owned restaurants, Contentment Museum and the New Haven Veterans’ Memorial.

MOUNT HOPE

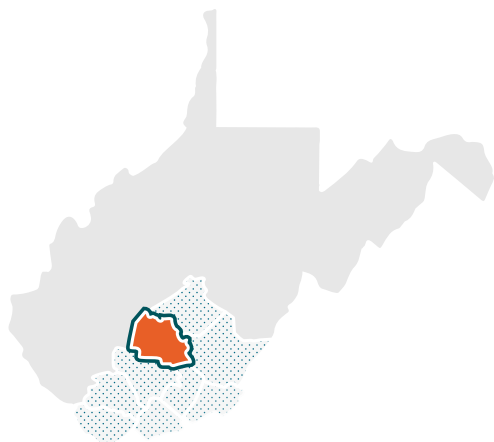
Historic Mount Hope offers adventurers a glimpse into what early life was like in the coalfields of West Virginia. The wealth generated from coal production is still visible in the stone structures lining the streets of this nostalgic little town. Featuring 16 historical points of interest, the Mount Hope Historic Walking Tour highlights the architecture reminiscent of the coalfields from the early 1900s. Tour DuBois on Main Museum, a tribute to one of two African American high schools before integration in Fayette County. Admire the town’s beautiful murals and streetscapes, adding to its charming character.

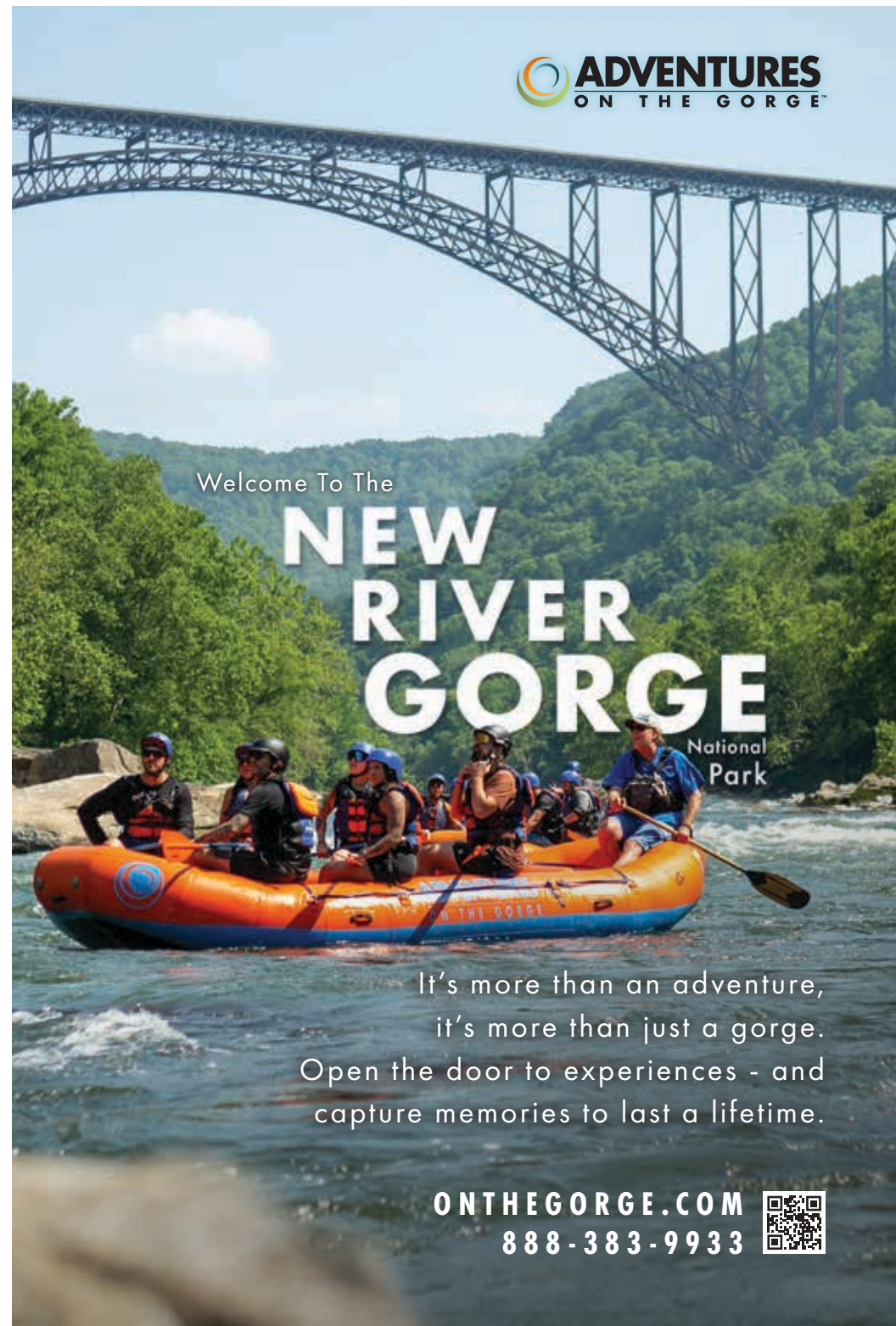

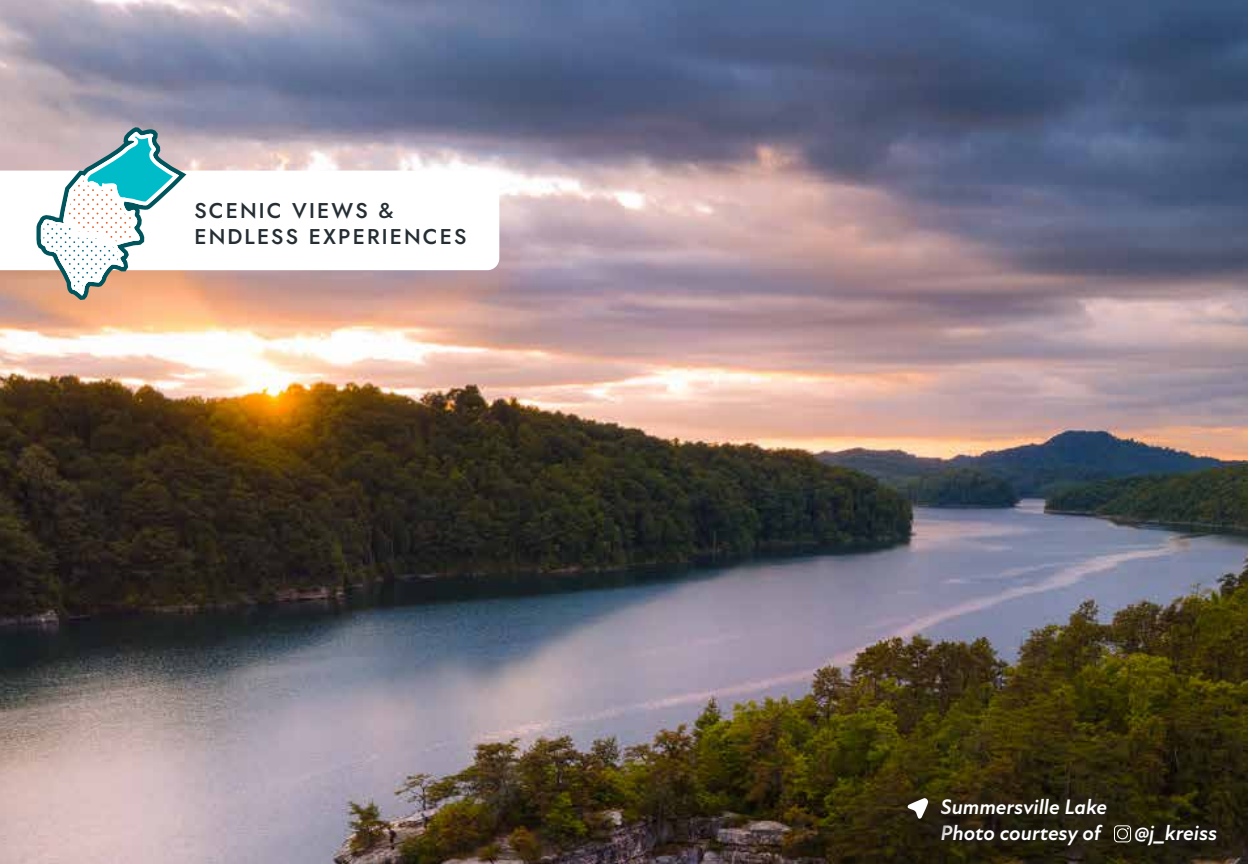

SUMMERSVILLE LAKE: ON & OFF THE WATER

NICHOLAS COUNTY

Known as the gateway to West Virginia’s mountain lakes region and home to the state’s largest lake, Nicholas County is an aquatic lover’s paradise.

Whether you’re looking to swim, boat, stand-up paddleboard or simply enjoy a picnic by the water, Nicholas County is the quintessential summertime destination. For those who prefer to stay on dry land, there are plenty of exciting activities off the water, too!

ON THE WATER

Nicholas County’s outdoor adventures revolve around its waterways, including its 2,700-acre sprawling lake and the rugged rapids of the Gauley River. Summersville Lake, the heart of the area, is a haven for boaters, paddle boarders, swimmers and divers. A full-service marina provides launch ramps and rentals of pontoons, canoes and flat-water kayaks. The lake’s calm waters make it a great option for weekend vacationers and novice boaters.

Summersville Lake, known as the “Little Bahamas of the East” for its crystal-clear waters, offers popular scuba diving. Reaching a depth of 327 feet, the lake provides excellent visibility of 20 to 45 feet in summer. Divers can explore underwater caverns, rock formations and diverse

marine life. The water, with temperatures ranging from 60 to 70 degrees, can reach up to 80 degrees during the hottest months.

The pristine lake has exceptional fishing opportunities for bass, crappie, walleye and more. Anglers can navigate 60 miles of scenic shoreline primarily by boat. Nicholas County boasts additional fishing gems, with spots along the Cherry River, Cranberry River, Gauley River, Little Laurel Creek and Deer Creek waiting to be explored by fishing enthusiasts.

The lake is not the only aquatic destination in the area. The world-famous Gauley River winds through Nicholas County, drawing in a crowd of whitewater extremists every fall for the renowned Gauley Season (on select days in September and October).

OFF THE WATER

Summersville Lake State Park, West Virginia's newest state park, spans 177 acres on the lake's northern shore. Not only is it the first state park added in over 30 years, but it also stands as the state's inaugural park with climbing access and a focus on climbing education. Presently the park offers hiking and biking trails and day-use picnic areas, with plans in progress for additional recreational activities like water sports, aerial sports, camping and cabins.

Climb the 122 steps to the gallery deck of the Summersville Lake Lighthouse,

the state's sole operational lighthouse. Situated on the Mt. Nebo side, it provides a 360-degree panoramic view of the lake and Gauley River National Recreation Area. Standing at 104 feet with a top elevation of 2,164 feet, the lighthouse's vintage Westinghouse beacon is visible up to 30 miles away. Tours run April through October, with reservations from November through March, offering day, evening, sunset and full-moon tours, weather permitting.

Nicholas County offers a range of accommodation options, from opulent rentals to charming cabins, and well-equipped campgrounds to serene tent sites. In addition to water recreation at Summersville Lake, visitors can also enjoy gem mining, miniature golf and local cuisine at nearby restaurants. Visit Kirkwood Winery and Isaiah Morgan Distillery for a unique West Virginia wine-tasting experience. Tour the distillery to learn about the Appalachian tradition of small-batch corn whiskey, and bring back a bottle to savor. Wrap up your day with a craft beer at Gad Dam Brewing in Summersville. This pet-friendly spot features fire pits, a spacious deck, outdoor games and more.

Explore the art, history and culture of Richwood, located in Nicholas County near the Monongahela National Forest. From Richwood, hop on the 16-mile Cranberry Tri-Rivers Rail Trail. The trail runs parallel to three scenic rivers — the Cranberry, Cherry and Gauley — providing hikers with access to fishing opportunities along the way. Richwood is the birthplace of the oldest ramp festival in the state — the Feast of the Ramson. The regional delicacy is celebrated every spring, and this year marks the 85th edition of the festival.

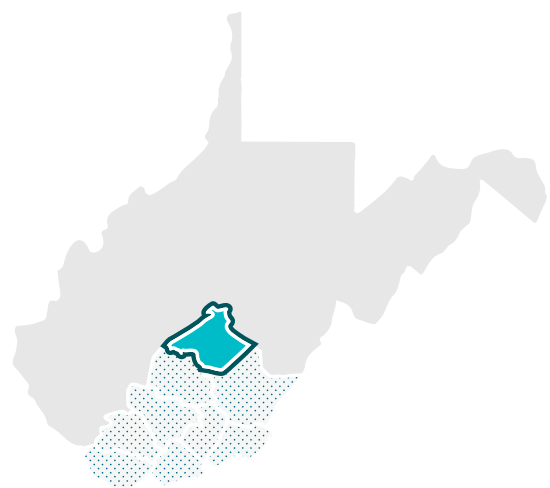
HISTORY IN NICHOLAS COUNTY

For history enthusiasts, Nicholas County is an essential stop. Explore the significance of Carnifex Ferry Battlefield State Park, situated on the Gauley River Canyon's rim, as it unfolds the narrative of a crucial Civil War battle. This 156-acre refuge commemorates the 1861 Battle of Carnifex Ferry, a turning point leading to the Confederate withdrawal from western Virginia. Explore other significant Civil War sites, including the Battle of Kessler's Cross Lanes and a memorial plaque for Nancy Hart, both part of the Civil War Trail and feature captivating narratives and media.

A mural depicting Hart can be found in Richwood, along with other murals celebrating the town's colorful past. A

walking tour is available with 51 stops throughout the community, including popular stores and restaurants from the town's heyday, historic churches, the Richwood B&O Railroad Depot and more. Visitors can learn about the history of the town, including its coal mines, lumber yards and railways, at the Richwood Heritage Center.

The Hawks Nest Workers Memorial and Grave Site in Lookout stands as a solemn reminder of the region's past. The memorial honors the estimated 764 tunnel workers, mostly African American, who tragically lost their lives building the Hawks Nest Tunnel during the 1930s. The site is part of the African American Heritage Driving Tour.

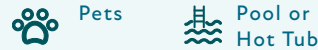

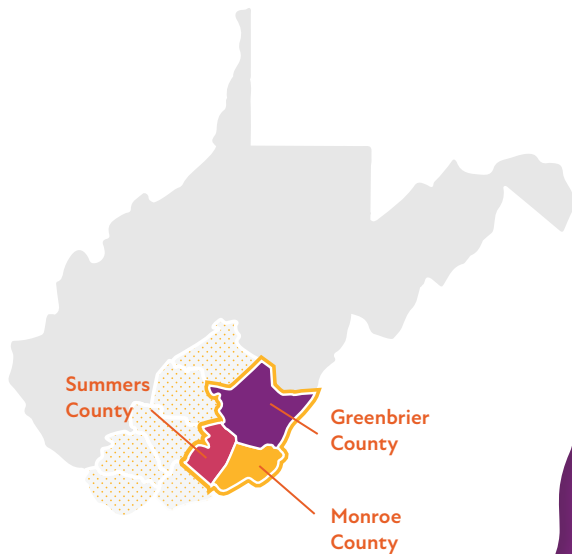

HINTON'S HISTORIC DISTRICT

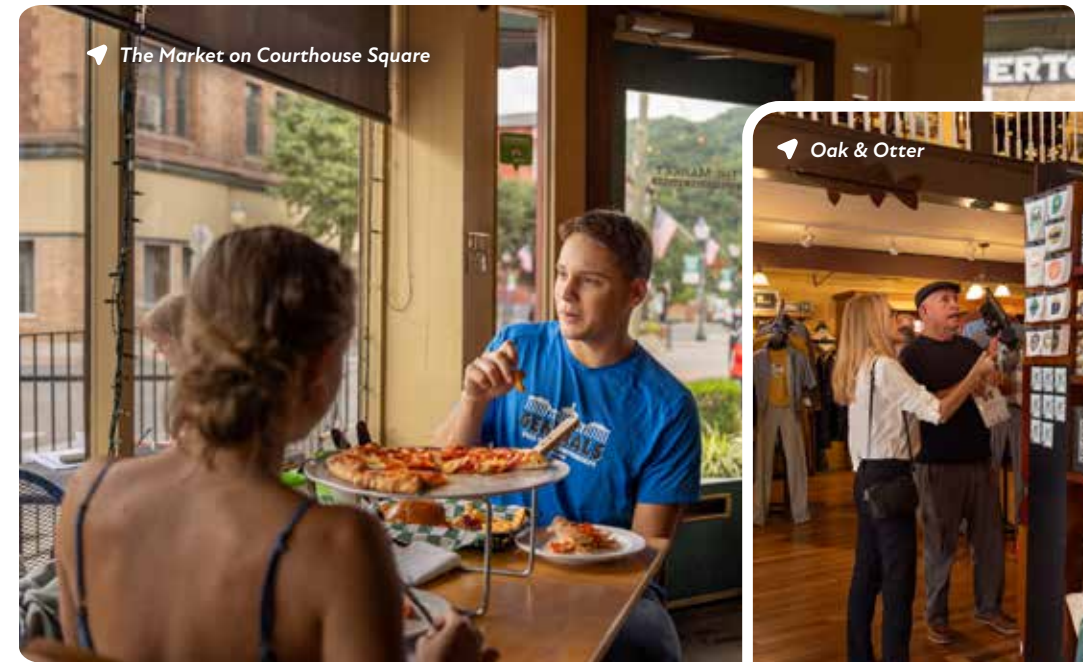
Hinton — the southeast entrance to New River Gorge National Park and Preserve — stands as a testament to community revitalizations while embodying West Virginia's cherished small-town charm.

Located in Summers County, a county of three rivers — the New, Bluestone and Greenbrier — Hinton boasts seemingly endless natural beauty.

Explore the Hinton Historic District, featuring 200 buildings that showcase diverse architectural styles. Within this district, discover delightful places to shop,

dine and relax. Stroll the brick streets, unraveling the charm of new shops and old architecture while surrounded by the breathtaking mountains and rivers.

Entertainment awaits at the remodeled Ritz Theater, offering movies, plays and music. Otter & Oak excels as a trifecta, offering the latest in outdoor gear and fashion,

complemented by a cozy cafe and the Rivertown Gallery, highlighting local art and books. Extend your time in Hinton with a stay at a historic inn, vacation rental or modern studio.

Hinton celebrates its community spirit with annual events like the West Virginia State Water Festival (July 20-27) and the Festival of the Rivers (September). The fall festival, Railroad Days, features food, music and vendors amidst the colorful foliage.

Journey north of Hinton to Sandstone Falls, a stunning cascade located in the New River Gorge National Park and

Preserve. It is the largest waterfall on the New River and spans 1,500 feet wide, with drops ranging from 10 to 25 feet. The New River transforms from a wide river to a narrow and powerful waterway at the falls. There are boardwalks, bridges and overlooks that offer excellent views and photo opportunities of the cascading water.

During the summer, cool off and make a splash with your family at Wild Water Express, an outdoor water park near Hinton's National Historic District.



UNIQUE PLACES TO VISIT IN SUMMERS COUNTY

Three Rivers Avian Center

Take a step back in time at one of Summers County's museums telling the stories of local legends and historical residences.



THREE RIVERS AVIAN CENTER

Founded in 1990, Three Rivers Avian Center is a nonprofit organization dedicated to wild bird conservation and ecosystem stewardship education. The 110-acre facility is located less than five miles from the Summers County seat of Hinton. Visitors can take a free public tour, typically on the first Saturday of the month from May–October, to meet and photograph some of the winged residents like owls, hawks, eagles, vultures and falcons. The Center also provides information about its ongoing work to protect, preserve and enhance wild bird species and their habitat through veterinary and rehabilitative care, environmental education, research and conservation efforts and species restoration.

THE MUSEUMS OF SUMMERS COUNTY

The museums of Summers County offer a diverse range of attractions, from historic homes to the renowned location of a local legend.

Begin your tour in Hinton by visiting the Campbell-Flannagan-Murrell House Museum, the town's oldest standing residence dating back to 1875. The Hinton Railroad Museum, illustrating the area's railway history and the Veterans Memorial Museum, displaying artifacts from the Revolutionary to Gulf wars, are also in the nearby vicinity.

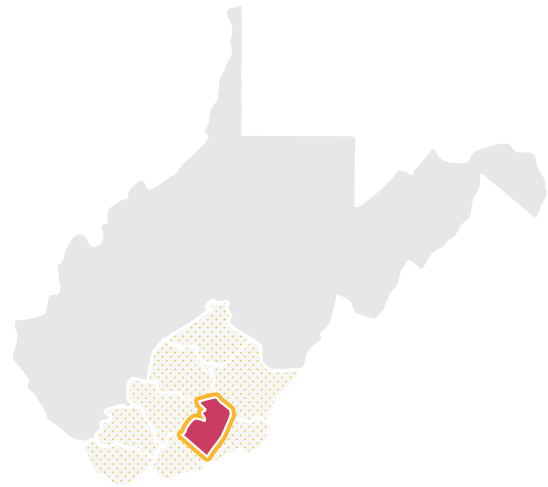
From Hinton, head east to Talcott, to pay homage to a folk hero at John Henry Historical Park. John Henry, known as the "Steel-Drivin' Man," is said to have raced —

and overcame (though subsequently dying with a hammer in his hand) — a steam-powered drilling machine in 1870 at Great Bend Tunnel. A statue has been erected in front of the tunnel, and a museum and gift shop are located in the former L.G. Rhodes General Store along Pat Ball Road. John Henry Days, an annual three-day festival, is held in July.

Proceed along Route 3 to the Historic Graham House, built in 1770 by Colonel James Graham, the first settler of the town of Lowell, West Virginia. The structure, which has been listed on the National Register of Historical Places since 1976, is the oldest log home in the state still standing on its original site. Also on the property is the Saunders One Room Schoolhouse. Both are open to visitors from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

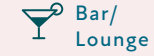

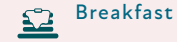

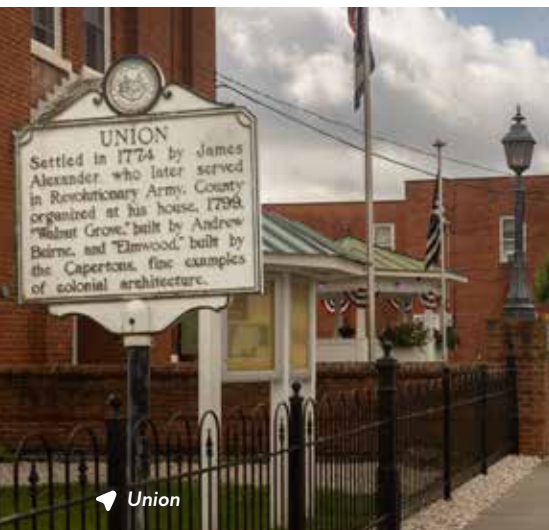

From restored covered bridges and historic churches to sprawling lakes and karst farmland, this area is an ideal escape for history buffs and nature lovers alike.

Located on the Virginia border, Monroe County is one of only two West Virginia counties in the state with access to the Appalachian Trail, the 2,200-mile famous footpath that spans from Maine to Georgia. The somewhat smaller — but still the longest in the state — Allegheny Trail is also located here. The two trails intersect at Peters Mountain. More hiking trails can be found in the George Washington and Jefferson national forests.

For birding enthusiasts, the Hanging Rock Raptor Observatory is a noteworthy destination. At an elevation of more than 3,800 feet, Hanging Rock is a former fire tower that is now noted for being one

of the best vantage points in the state to view migrating hawks, eagles, falcons and osprey along with a panorama of the surrounding counties. The hike to access the tower is close to a mile and can take up to 40 minutes depending on your fitness level.

Located nearby, Moncove Lake State Park also offers hiking, bird watching and water activities. Visitors can enjoy boating and fishing on the lake's tranquil waters. There are five hiking trails, and the park's

campground and pool are open seasonally — spring through fall, weather permitting.

The area beautifully preserves its historic features, including Cook's Old Mill, a mid-1800s gristmill on West Virginia Route 122, and the Indian Creek Covered Bridge, located near US Route 219 and proudly listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Additionally, visit quaint towns like Alderson and Union for a glimpse of the past.

Agriculture is at the heart of Monroe County. For an up-close look at some of the local producers, visit Sunset Berry Farm & Produce, which specializes in growing strawberries, sweet corn and watermelon. The farm also has beautiful fields of sunflowers that are in full bloom during the late summer.

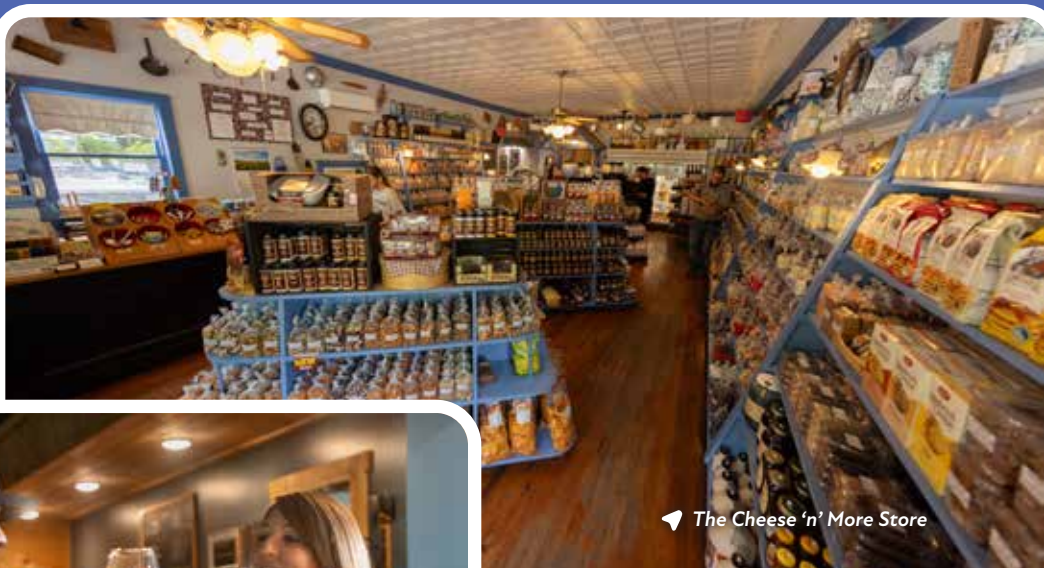

Visit Alderson Store, established in 1887 and West Virginia's oldest store, for a nostalgic shopping experience. Drink in the great flavor of the area at Old World Libations, a farm winery located in Union. Old World Libations crafts fine ciders, meads and wines using

West Virginia fruits and berries straight from the source. Alderson Artisans Gallery, a non-profit community art hub, highlights handmade art and crafts from local and Appalachian artisans. Four Fillies Lodge provides diverse accommodations on over 80 acres, including log cabins, glamping pods, a safari lodge and more. Immerse yourself in history at Sweet Springs Resort Park, featuring the historic Sweet Springs Hotel designed by Thomas Jefferson in 1830. Providing lodging and baths since 1760, the resort is available for special events, festivals and tours.

CIVIL WAR HISTORY IN MONROE COUNTY

Monroe County boasts a rich Civil War history, evident in its five sites on the National Civil War Trail, all conveniently located within walking distance of the town of Union.

CHAPMAN HOUSE

Built in 1803, this house belonged to a prominent Union family with Confederate ties. Augustus Chapman, a well-known lawyer and politician, served as a brigadier general in the Confederate army. His son, George, also fought for the Confederacy, leading Chapman's Battery until his death at the Battle of Winchester in 1864.

GENERAL JOHN ECHOLS HOUSE

This residence was home to John Echols, a lawyer and Confederate general. He played a significant role in the war, forming the Monroe Guards militia company and later commanding Confederate forces in the Kanawha Valley and Western Virginia.

UNION COLLEGE

Founded in 1820, this former Presbyterian school stands as the oldest private school building still standing in West Virginia. During the war, it served as a hospital for injured Confederate soldiers left behind by General Heth's troops in 1862.

CROOK'S OCCUPATION OF UNION

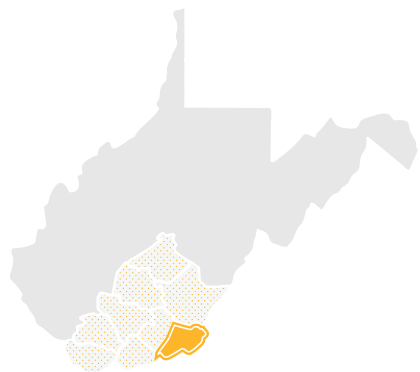
This marker commemorates the Union army's occupation of Union under General Crook in May 1864. During this time, a large Union force, including future presidents Rutherford B. Hayes and William McKinley, marched through the town.

UNION, WESTERN VIRGINIA

This monument, erected in 1901, honors the local men who served the Confederacy. Standing atop a hill, it overlooks Walnut Grove, a house used as a hospital during the Union occupation, and offers a glimpse into the town's layout during the Civil War.

A VIBRANT ODE TO THE PAST

GREENBRIER COUNTY

First-class restaurants, fine art galleries, historic museums and scenic hiking trails — Greenbrier County appeals to all preferences.

Lewisburg, one of America's Coolest Small Towns, is known for its small-town ambiance and metropolitan sophistication. Historians to art enthusiasts to craft beer connoisseurs can all delight in the charms of this small town.

The 263-acre nationally registered Downtown Lewisburg Historic District offers a peek into the area's notable past. Set out on a self-guided walking tour to learn about Lewisburg's 18th and 19th-century history, founders and architecture.

Embark on an underground cave tour at Lost World Caverns just outside of Lewisburg.

Browse local galleries and boutiques or get a taste of the thriving food scene. Attend a show at Greenbrier Valley Theatre or Lewisburg's Carnegie Hall, one of four left in the world still in use, and a cultural center for art, music and theater. In the summer, attend the annual State Fair of West Virginia.

Near Carnegie Hall is the Confederate Cemetery, the final resting place of 95 unidentified Confederate soldiers, and the North House Museum, managed by the Greenbrier Historical Society.

In addition to the chic bistros and sidewalk cafes lining the streets of downtown, Lewisburg is home to Greenbrier Valley Brewing Company, one of the state's most popular independent breweries. Sip on a locally-crafted brew, or visit West Virginia's first cidery, Hawk Knob Appalachian Hard Cider. For a taste of West Virginia-made whiskey, stop by Smooth Ambler Spirits Distillery.

Embark on an underground adventure at Lost World Caverns, a remarkable cave tour located just outside of Lewisburg. Prefer something more relaxing? Head to White Sulphur Springs for a soothing day at the Salt Cave and Spa. While in the area, take a stroll down Main Street and discover some of the new businesses popping up. White Sulphur Springs is a thriving Monongahela National Forest town.

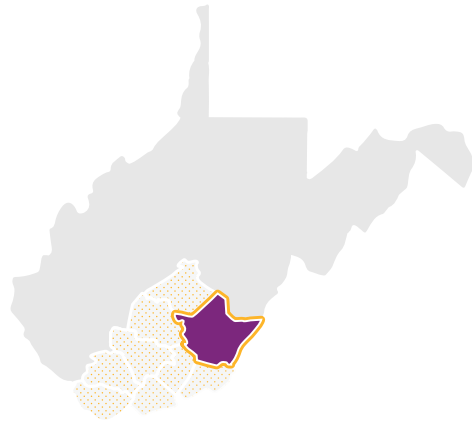
Admire the rolling landscapes of Greenbrier County during an outdoor excursion. Visit local covered bridges (Herns Mill in Lewisburg and Hokes Mill in Ronceverte), hike, bike or horseback ride along the 78-mile Greenbrier River Trail or explore part of the Greenbrier State Forest, a 5,200-acre forest located on the eastern border of the state.

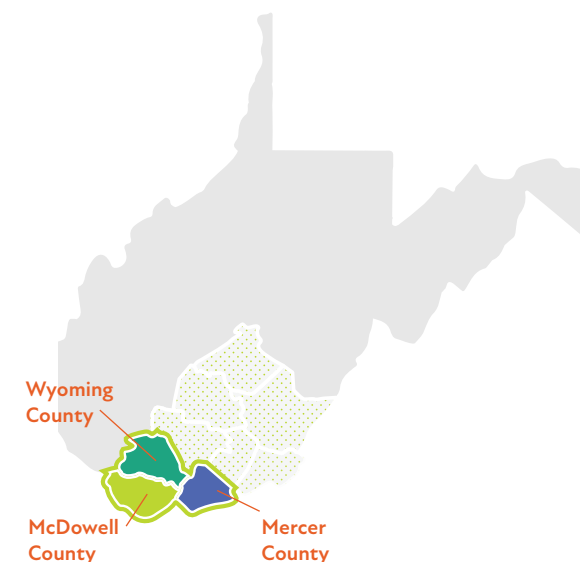
Historic Coalfields & OFF-ROAD ADVENTURES

WYOMING COUNTY | MCDOWELL COUNTY | MERCER COUNTY

Going off-the-beaten path is the best direction. From tackling the trails to exploring rich coal history, there's something waiting for everyone in Wyoming, Mercer and McDowell counties.

This area is known for off-roading, thanks to the famous Hatfield-McCoy Trails System that runs through it. ATVs, UTVs and dirt bikes are all welcome here, at any time of the year.

Experience more of the great outdoors by visiting the region's three state parks, each featuring stunning waterfalls, scenic overlooks and miles of hiking and biking trails. With museums, coal camps, military monuments and a living history farm, there are plenty of activities for history buffs, too!





WYOMING COUNTY MOUNTAIN GETAWAY

Captivating waterfalls, living history and trail riding – Wyoming County has activities for the entire family.

Enter a world of pristine forests and starry nights at Twin Falls Resort State Park, a nearly 4,000-acre hidden treasure in Mullens. The park offers year-round accommodations which include campsites, cabins and the main lodge, as well as over 30 miles of hiking and biking trails.

Follow the Falls Trail and admire the two picturesque cascades on the property — Foley Falls and Black Fork Falls. The park’s namesake “twin falls” are located half a mile apart on the Marsh and Black Forks of Cabin Creek and can be accessed by a short hike from the trailhead parking lot. Both waterfalls are seasonal and are best to visit in the wet spring months.

COAL HERITAGE

Wyoming County’s history, much like other parts of Southern West Virginia, is tied to the coal boom of the 20th century. Remnants of this bygone era can be found in still-standing coal camps throughout the county. Historic remains such as a company store, houses, steel rail bridge and coal tippie from one of the most productive mines in the state during the 1950s and 60s, Itmann, can be found here. Mullens was another boom town in the 20th century due to the Virginian Railway main line, rail yard and repair shop. The first commercial coal mine in the county was opened here. Take a tour of downtown to see the buildings and murals depicting a vanished period. From Mullens, follow the National Coal Heritage Trail. This driving route travels through more than 187 rugged miles of scenic industrial heritage and commemorates the history and culture of the coal industry.

While at the park, make a stop at Pioneer Farm, a reconstructed 1830s homestead that gives visitors a glimpse of true frontier life. Although you cannot tour the buildings, make sure to bring your camera — the farm is one of the top photographed attractions in the West Virginia State Park system!

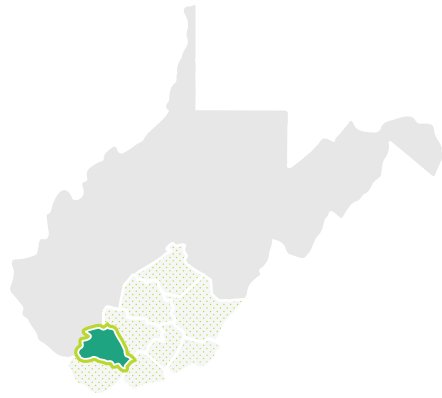
Other recreational activities at the park include an 18-hole golf course, splash park, nature center, indoor swimming pool, outdoor amphitheater, geocaching course, mountain bike trails, and tennis, basketball and volleyball courts.

Kick up some dust on the Hatfield-McCoy trails. Wyoming County is home to the Pinnacle Creek Trail System, 80 miles of off-road territory and the most scenic section of the Hatfield-McCoy Trail System. The Pinnacle Creek Trailhead, connected to Warrior, Pocahontas and Indian Ridge trails, creates the largest trail group on the Hatfield-McCoy Trail System.

Camp Creek State Park & Forest

For more outdoor adventures, visit Panther State Forest, West Virginia’s southernmost state forest, offering 7,810 rugged acres for nature escapes. In Mercer County, Camp Creek State Park and Forest features breathtaking waterfalls, trails and stocked trout streams, while Pinnacle Rock State Park showcases a striking 3,100-foot sandstone formation.

Beyond the trails, enjoy cultural performances at the Chuck Mathena Center in Princeton, a unique venue with a nearly 1,000-seat theatre hosting national touring productions, off-Broadway shows, concerts and more. A Bluefield landmark, the Historic Granada Theater opened in 1928 and hosted many famous celebrities before closing in the late 20th century. Revitalized by the community, the theater reopened to its former glory in 2021, and now brings movies and live events to Mercer County.

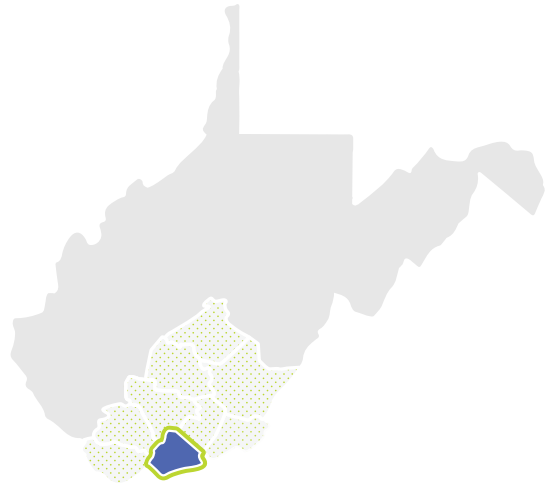

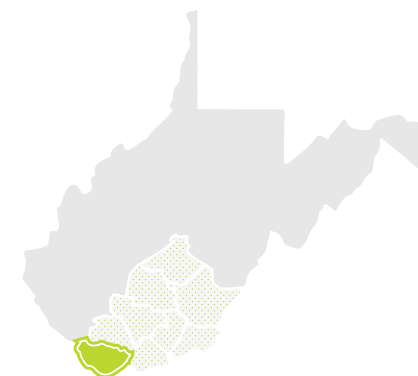

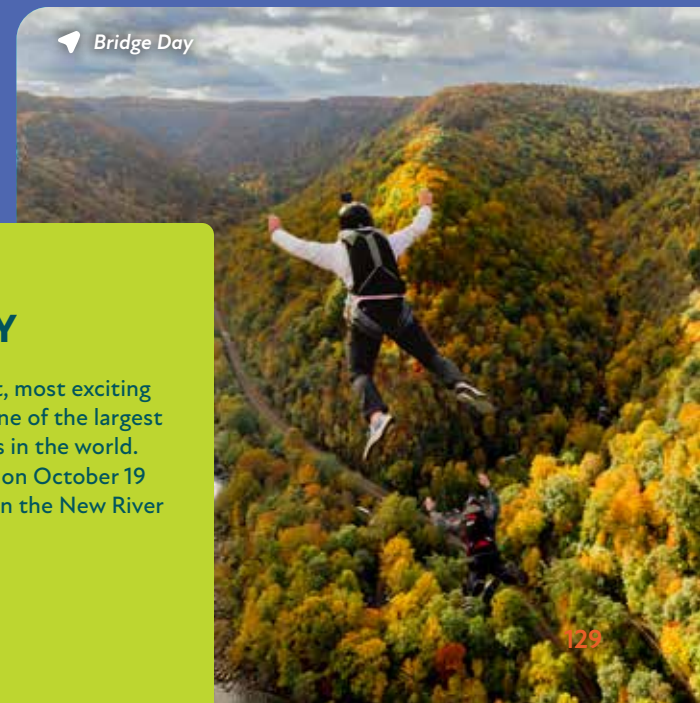
